

The Gift of Life

Kidney Donation

A life-long Marine Park resident and 15-year veteran NYC public school teacher is in need of a living kidney donor to continue working and educating New York's youth. If you or someone you know is willing to donate a kidney, please read further and start the process giving the gift of life.

Donor Requirements:

- 21 years or older
- Male or Female
- Blood type - "O" (positive or negative)



Donating Procedure:

1. A transplant coordinator will conduct a brief phone medical evaluation.
2. A blood test will be scheduled to check blood-match and compatibility.
3. If a good blood-match is established, a few other non-invasive tests will be scheduled depending on donor's age, gender, and medical history.

During each step you will be asked if you wish to proceed further in the testing, and at any point you may decline.

All medical expenses are covered. There are no out-of-pocket medical expenses to potential donors for testing, and donating.

A recovery time of 2-3 weeks is typical to resume work and normal activities after donating a kidney.
